Dear Parents & Carers,

As we move towards the month of December, we have a range of seasonal events and concerts lined up. Reception places are allocated in a cross London scheme which is organised by our local authority, Hackney Learning Trust, not the school. If you have a child who was born between 1st September 2015 to 31st August 2016 then you will need to make an application for a Reception place regardless of whether your child attends our Nursery or has a sibling already in the school. Our Reception classes are very popular so don't miss the deadline for these applications which is Tuesday 15th January 2020. 
COFFEE MORNINGS
