Our topic this half term is 'Let's Celebrate'

Communication and Language

We will be learning to listen to stories and other children when they are talking.

We will be learning to understand simple instructions.

We will be learning to use simple sentences when talking.

We will be learning to ask questions.



Literacy

We will enjoy a range of stories and picture books. We will retell stories using props and puppets.

We will be singing and adding actions and musical instruments to nursery rhymes and songs.

We will talk about our writing.

We will learn about alliteration from our story books.

Mathematics

We will be learning to sing number rhymes.

We will be reciting and ordering numbers in order to 10.

We will be counting objects.

We will be using the language of size such as 'big and small.'

We will be naming identifying shapes in our environment.

Physical Development

We will be using a range of equipment to make marks.

We will practise holding our pencil with a tripod grip.

We will be thinking about and practising different ways to move.

We will be talking about ways we can keep our bodies healthy and why it is important to exercise.

We will practise getting ourselves dressed, putting on our coats and taking our shoes and socks off for PE.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring different objects by looking, tasting, touching and smelling.

We will be talking about our friends and families. We will explore our environment and ask questions about things that interest us.

We will be using the CD player Bee-Bots and iPads.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be experimenting different ways of painting and drawing.

We will be learning new songs and rhymes and exploring movement.

We will be dancing and joining in with ring games. We will be learning instrument names and how to play them.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be making our own choices during play. We will be making friends with the other children. We will be playing alongside other children. We can talk about our feelings and how other children may be feeling.
