This week we celebrated **anti-bullying week** and, although our school is a happy and safe place, we have a number of ways in which we tackle any bullying that might occur. We encourage children to speak up where there are issues, and to know the difference between a disagreement and bullying. There are several different forms of bullying, and children have been learning about what to do if they feel someone is being unkind to them either in person or online. Children are encouraged to report anything which is upsetting them to an adult, but also to tell the person they are unhappy with how they are feeling. DROP IN SESSIONS FOR PARENTS


