Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning to follow class rules and routines. We will be making our own choices during play. We will be making friends with other children in Robin Class.

Physical Development

We will be using ribbon sticks, paintbrushes and chalk to make large movements. We will be talking about ways we can keep our body healthy. We will be playing moving and stopping games.
