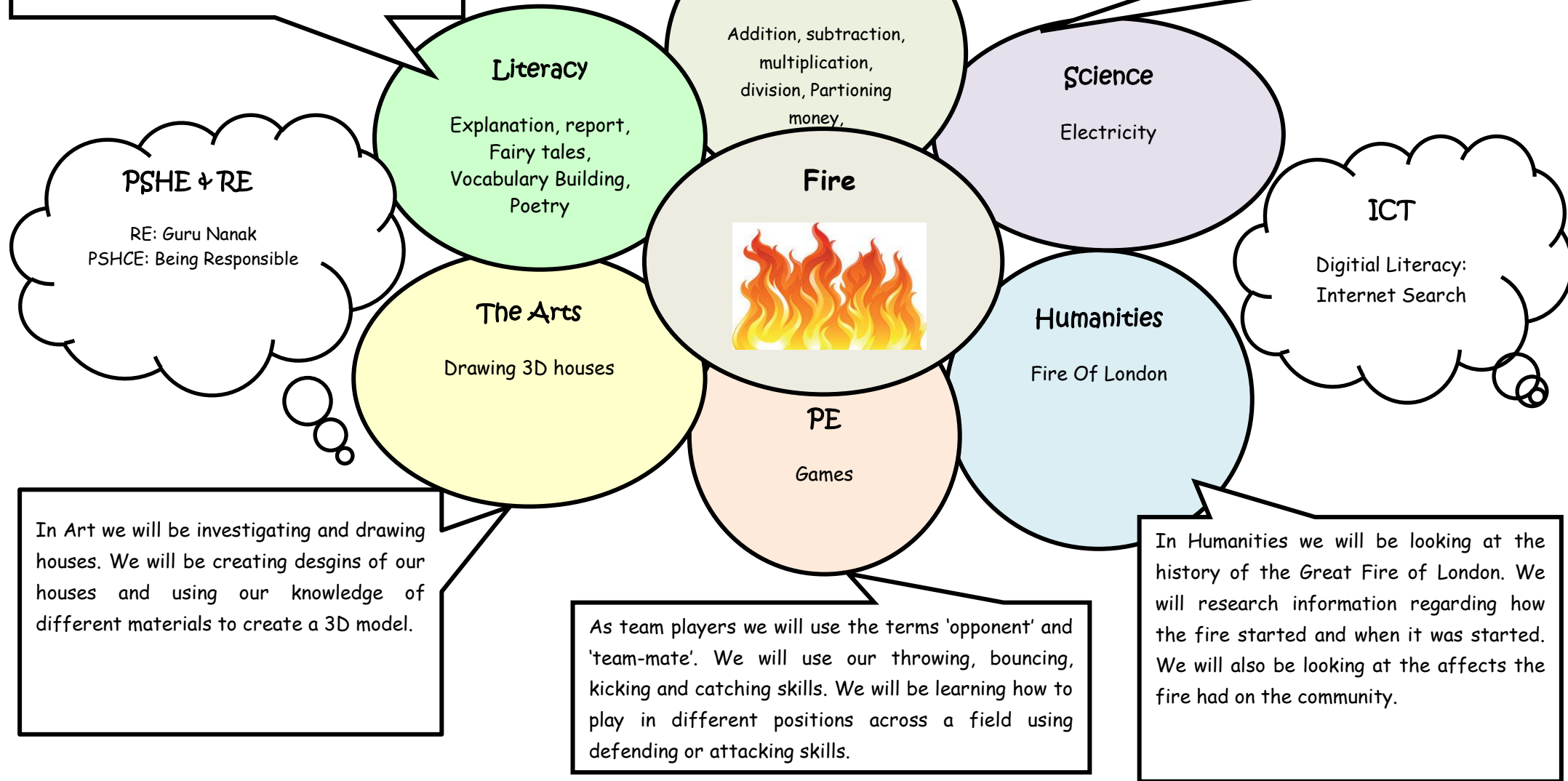

In Literacy, we will be doing lots of reading and writing. We will start off by writing our own Fairy tales. We will then be looking at writing explanations and reports. Throughout the term, we will also be building on our vocabulary. At the end of the half term, we will be analysing a poem and coming up with our own poems.

In Numeracy we will start by adding and subtracting using 100 squares and practicing our number bonds to 20. We will then be looking at partitioning, multiplication and division. Throughout the half term we will also be building upon our problem solving and mental maths skills.

In Science we will be learning about electricity. We will be looking at different ways electricity is generated and why it is useful. During the half term, we will be making predictions and experimenting with different materials.
