### Dear Parents and Carers.

You should now have received the curriculum newsletter for the second half of the Autumn Term. These detail the learning for the year group including PE days. Physical Education (PE) is a statutory part of the curriculum and essential for both physical and mental well-being. Please ensure your child has their full kit each week to enable them to access the learning comfortably and safely.

As we move towards the month of December, we have a range of seasonal events and sing-alongs lined up. We have listed some of these on the back of this newsletter but please also look out for posters on gates and information on our website and social media. We will of course be teaching a full timetable until the holidays and children are expected to attend school every day until then. In recognition of the Platinum Jubilee an additional bank holiday has been included in the 2021/22 academic year. The Government have acknowledged that the identified date for this (3rd June 2022) falls in half term and leaves school staff and pupils without the benefit of the extra day holiday. Legislation has now been changed for this year only to reduce the normal teaching requirement to 189 days (instead of 190). Schools can opt to select the chosen day and our school have opted for the additional bank holiday on the 17th December 2021. This means the term for all pupils will finish on Thursday 16th December at 2pm.

A letter inviting you to parents evening on **Thursday 9th December**, along with details of the online booking system, will be sent home to you next week. We are keen to make sure that all parents meet with teachers and discuss their child's progress as well as take up the opportunity to look through their workbooks and celebrate their hard work, so if you haven't seen the letter, or are finding it difficult to make an appointment please call the school office so that we can help.

Reception school places are allocated in a cross London scheme which is organised by our local authority, Hackney Education, not the school. If you have a child who was born between born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018 then you will need to make an application for a Reception place regardless of whether your child attends our Nursery or has a sibling already in the school. Our Reception classes are very popular so don't miss the deadline for these applications which is Saturday 15th January 2022. 
# **COFFEE MORNINGS**
