Eco-Schools Topic 1 ENERGY	Action(s): -Locate the energy meter -Track the energy meter over the next 3 months - Encourage children and teachers to turn light off when not in use - Deliver stickers to be places on switches to remind people to switch lights off - Celebrate the class that saves more energy by always turning lights and monitors off when not in use	How long will it take? Ongoing	How will we monitor progress? Tracking the energy meter Regular inspections to classrooms and offices to check if lights and monitors are off Making sure all children know why it is important to save energy
Aim: To reduce the amount of energy we use as a school		Who is responsible? Eco-schools lead Green team	Evaluation: Identify areas with poor energy behaviour and provide support. Children to deliver short sessions on the importance of saving energy.
Eco-Schools Topic 2 WATER	Action(s): -Create a culture where children, staff, parents and carers understand that tap water is safe to drink. - Create posters to encourage children to use reusable bottles -Price (a nice plant) for the class with no plastic bottles.	How long will it take? 3 months (to collect data) and monitor campaign	How will we monitor progress? Regular visits to classrooms to count plastic bottles Target children with plastic bottles and offer advice on where to get them.
Aim: To reduce the number of plastic bottles children and staff use.		Who is responsible? Eco-schools lead Green team	Evaluation: Children in Years 5 and 6 to create a bar charts to show data. Target classes with the highest number of plastic bottles and identify the reason. Inform where to get reusable bottles at reasonable price.
Eco-Schools Topic 3 LITTER	Action(s): -To arrange litter picking sessions to ensure there's no litter in the areas closer to our school -Identify areas where litter could be a problem and contact authorities (Hackney Council) to place more bins or these are emptied regularly.	How long will it take? Ongoing	How will we monitor progress? Regular visits at different times of the day. Communication with Hackney Council regarding placing more bins. Bins to be empty regularly.
