This week we held our World Book Day events, an important opportunity to celebrate the love of reading. There were many children and staff dressed up as their favourite book character and many conversations about favourite stories throughout the day. Look out for photographs on our Facebook and Twitter pages! We are constantly refreshing our home reader libraries so that children have a breadth of books to read. Please help us with this by making sure that children read every night and record their reading in their home school diaries. Don't forget that there are also example questions that you can ask in the diaries, this helps children to develop their understanding and comprehension skills.

We are continuing to invest in annual subscriptions for Mathletics and Times Table Rock Stars online learning programmes so that children in Years 1 to 6 can access them at home as well as at school for free. All children have their own password to log on to the site (usually in their home school diaries). These both offer fun and interactive ways to learn key maths skills such as times tables and number bonds.

Thank you to all the parents who completed our parent survey last term. We had 232 responses from parents of children in all year groups. We are very pleased that:

- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that the school provides a good education for their child.
- 100% agreed or strongly agreed that their child feels that their teachers work hard and teach well.

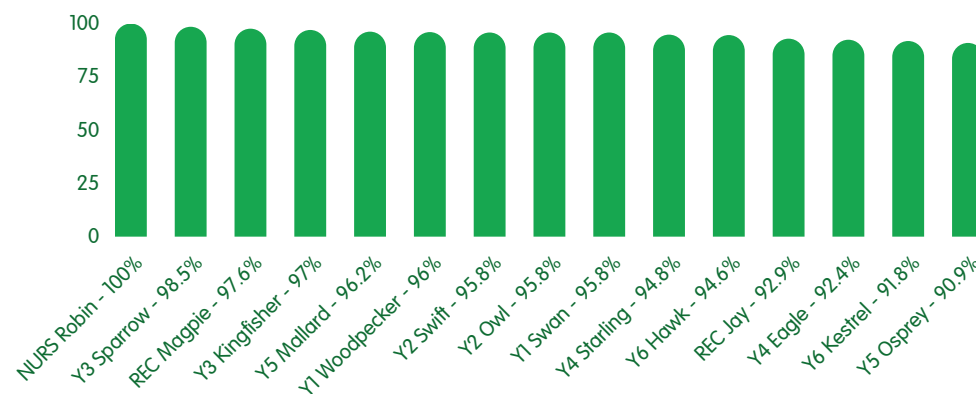
