Dear Sirs,

In reply to your query, please note the following:

- 1. The consumption of Alcohol is prohibited even if it is taken in a small quantity provided a bigger quantity leads to intoxication.
- 2. The application of fluoride varnish on teeth is treated as external application, not as a drink. Furthermore, the alcohol is used after being mixed with other chemicals which certainly doesn't lead to intoxication. So there is nothing wrong in applying it on the teeth.
- 3. It would be preferred if it is made known to parents through a handout or a letter that the Primary Care Unit is satisfied to use it externally after consulting Islamic Sharia Council.
