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Dear Sirs,

In reply to your query, please note the following:

1. The consumption of Alcohol is prohibited even if it is taken in a small quantity provided a bigger quantity leads to intoxication.
2. The application of fluoride varnish on teeth is treated as external application, not as a drink. Furthermore, the alcohol is used after being mixed with other chemicals which certainly doesn't lead to intoxication. So there is nothing wrong in applying it on the teeth.
3. It would be preferred if it is made known to parents – through a handout or a letter – that the Primary Care Unit is satisfied to use it externally after consulting Islamic Sharia Council.
