<b>Introductions</b>	<p>Ms Ani welcomed everyone to School Council. We looked at the school council folder and the expectations of the folder and the role of a school councillor. We also spoke about why we wanted to be part of school council</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ibrahim – I am very responsible and I want to represent my class</li> <li>- Summer – My friend used to be school council and she enjoyed the role so I thought it would be fun</li> <li>- Nico– I find it fun to have a voice to make decisions in the school</li> <li>- Goldie– I wanted to have some responsibility to make changes in the school</li> <li>- Eliza – It’s a fun role and you help to add important additions to the school</li> </ul>	

<p><b>Anti-Bullying</b></p>	<p>This week, we discussed what bullying means, what it looks like and what to do if you feel you are being bullied</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Bullying means when you pick on someone repeatedly – not just once.</li> <li>- Bullying can be physical and mental</li> <li>- Some people get a bit confused when something is unkind verses bullying</li> <li>- If you are bullied then you should tell a trusted adult either at school or at home</li> <li>- If you don't want to talk to someone, you can write it in your class problem and praise box</li> <li>- The peer mediators can help with smaller issues that come up and it's good that they have had special training</li> <li>- The difference between a disagreement is when you may not agree on a topic but bullying could be on home life/ personal and come towards</li> </ul>	<p>SC to encourage peers to use problem and praise box if they don't want to talk to an adult</p> <p>SC to ensure that peer mediators know what to do if someone is being bullied</p>
